



Household Hazardous Waste Items

The following items are NOT acceptable at any of our landfills even in household waste.

Items that are NOT acceptable include:

- **Tires** of any type (truck, auto, farm, etc.)
- **Lead-Acid Batteries** (e.g. auto)
- **Liquid Paint** (dried paints are usually acceptable)
- **Liquid Used Oil**
- **Landscape Waste** (from the cutting and trimming of grass, leaves, bushes, trees, etc.)
- **Animal Carcasses** (unless approved by WAC)
- **Medical Sharps** (unless containerized)
- **Mercury Thermostats**
- **White Goods** (e.g. refrigerators, ranges, freezers, air conditioners, humidifiers, dehumidifiers, stoves, ovens, water heaters, clothes dryers, washers, dish washers, water coolers, heat pumps, chillers, furnaces, and boilers).
- **Electronic Waste** (effective 1/1/12) including Computers (desktop or notebook), Computer Monitors, Printers, Televisions, Electronic Keyboards, Facsimile Machines, Videocassette Recorders, Portable Digital Music Players, Digital Video Disk Players, Video Game Consoles, Small Scale Servers, Scanners, Electronic Mice, Digital Converter Boxes, Cable Receivers, Satellite Receivers, Digital Video Disc Players
- **Asphalt Roofing Shingles** (effective 1/1/14) - @ *CLI & ICL only*
- **Propane Tanks or Compressed Gas Cylinders** (unless approved by WAC)
