▲ Trash and Recycling pickup ■ Holiday

Please have your trash and recyclables at the curb by **5:00 a.m.**

- #1 through #7 (except #6 - Styrofoam)
- Plastics, excluding those that have contained hazardous or flammable chemicals
- Cardboard broken down no larger than 2 ft. x 2 ft., bundled or contained
- Newspapers, catalogs, phone books, magazines and junk mail
- Steel, aluminum and bi-metal cans
- Clear glass bottles and jars
- Cereal and gift boxes

All containers must be rinsed out before pickup. This will reduce contamination and odors. All recyclables must be in a well-marked container.

Place your cart with the handle facing your house. The lid opens from the street/alley toward the house.
